This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.J.Chandran, learned counsel for the appellant and Mr.R.Ramesh, learned counsel for the first respondent are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they have arrived at a compromise to settle the case as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs 15,98,700/- with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the petition till the date of realization as compensation to the 1st respondent / claimant. Challenging the

2. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have mutually agreed to modify the award amount to a sum of Rs.23,00,000/- in full quit. The award of the Tribunal is modified accordingly.

3. The appellant / Insurance Company has already deposited 50% of the award amount together with interest thereon. The appellant / Insurance Company undertakes to deposit the balance award amount as per the modified award within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this settlement order.

4. On such deposit being made, the Tribunal shall transfer the same to the savings bank account of the 1st respondent / claimant through RTGS forthwith, on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

5 Accordingly the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of .
Consequently connected civil miscellaneous petition, if any is closed.

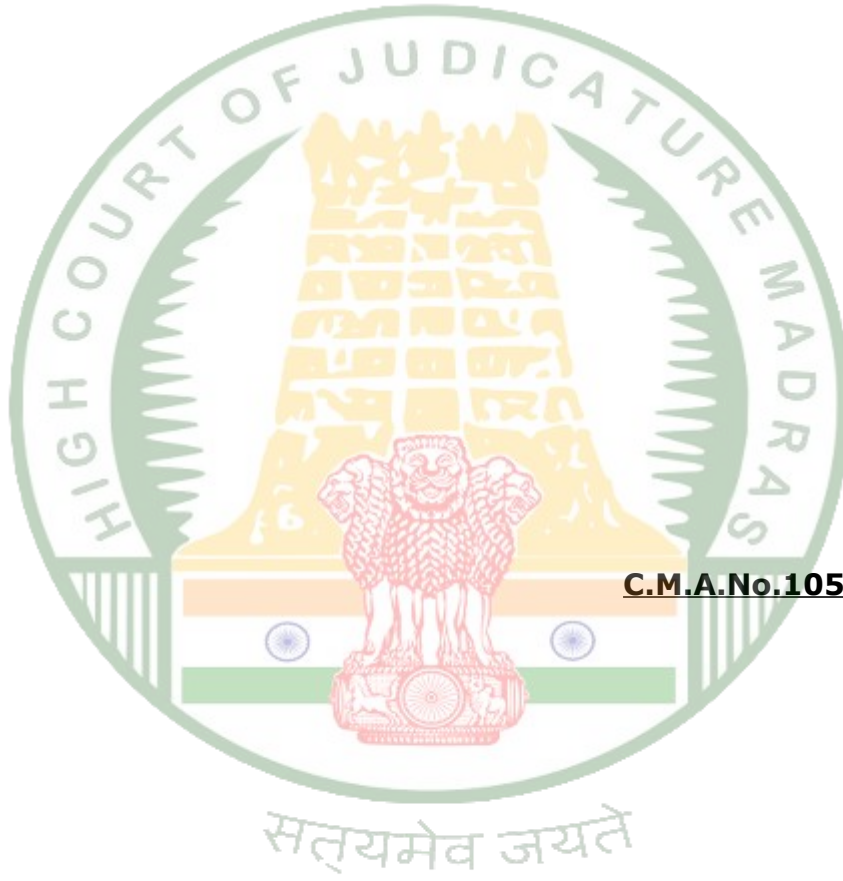
