PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus calling for the records in connection with the order of Detention passed by the second respondent 25.01.2020 in B3-D.O. No. 06/2020 against the petitioner son Sasikumar @ Sasi, Male 28 years S/o. Lakshmanan who is confined at Central Prison, Vellore, and set aside the same and direct the respondents to produce the detenue before the Court and set him at liberty.

2.The Petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in B3-D.O. No. 06/2020 dated 25.01.2020 detaining her son as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O. Rt. No. 523, Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 29.01.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
