2. This writ petition is filed to quash the order dated 30.04.2010 whereby the Petitioner was relieved from service with effect from 30.04.2010 by rejecting the claim for alteration of his date of birth. While the writ petition was pending, the Petitioner died on 29.07.2016.

3. Given the nature of the legal claim, namely, a request for alteration of date of birth, in my view, nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition at this juncture. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. None the less, the disposal of the writ petition shall not preclude the legal

heirs of the Petitioner from making claims for any monetary benefits to which they may be entitled as per applicable rules. No costs.

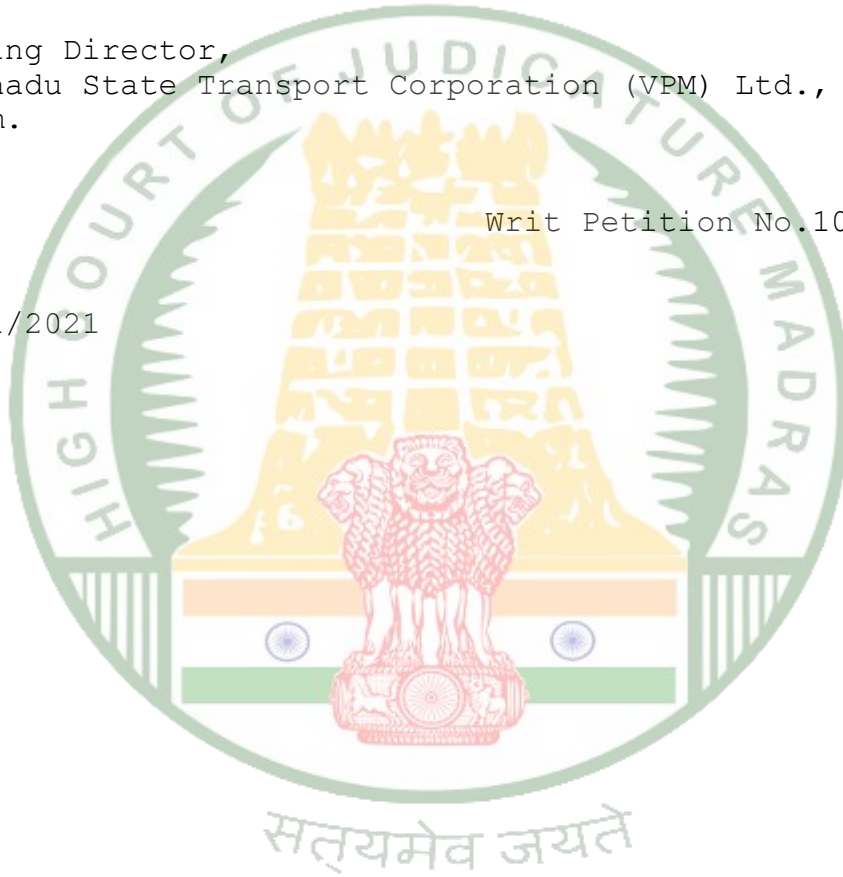
