PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus calling for the records of the 1st respondent herein concerned in C2/753/2020 dated 13.01.2020 quashing the same, directing the respondents herein to produce the body and person of the detenu by name K.Sridhar male aged 39 years, S/o.Krishnamoorthy, before this Court and setting him at liberty now detained in Central Prison, Cuddalore.

2.The Petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in C2/753/2020 dated 13.01.2020 detaining her husband as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

3.The learned Counsel for the Petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this petition as the Government has already revoked the detention order passed against the detenu.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O. Rt. No.799, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIV) Department, dated 17.02.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
