Prayer in W.P. No. 2012 of 2012:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records and quash the impugned order of the First Respondent issued under Section 12AA(3) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 bearing DIT (E) No. 2(412)/97-98/12AA(3)/2011-12 dated 26.12.2011 and direct the First Respondent to continue the exemption under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as claimed by the Petitioner forthwith.

Prayer in W.P. No. 2013 of 2012:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records and quash

the impugned order of the Second Respondent issued under Section 143(3) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, bearing PAN/GI No. AAATP5011E dated 28.12.2011 for the assessment year 2009-2010.

Prayer in W.P. No. 2014 of 2012:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Declaration, declaring the provisos to Section 2(15) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as ultra vires and unconstitutional as the same is in violation of Article 14, 265 and 300A of the Constitution of India.

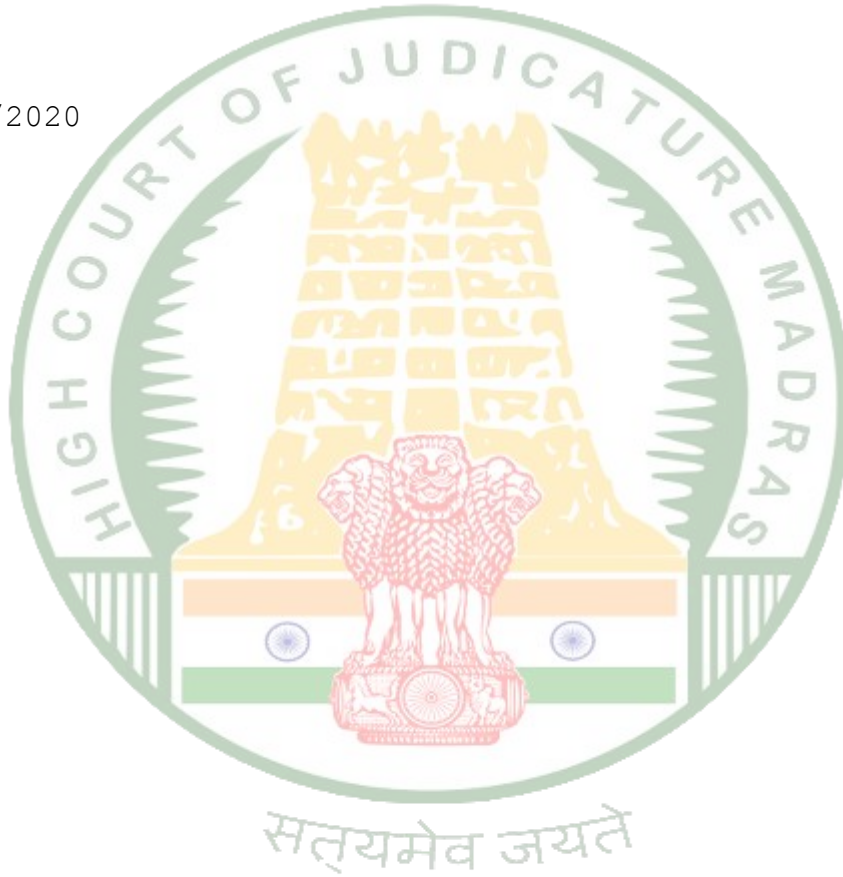
