PRAYER : Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the proceedings of the 1st respondent dated 25.07.2003 made in Mu.Mu.No.31937/N2/2003 and the consequential order passed by the 2nd respondent dated 05.02.2005 made in Mu.Pa.No.1852/1999 (S2), quash the same and consequently direct the 1st respondent to decide the petitioner's appeal Memorandum dated 30.06.2003 on merits.
