PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned selection process of the 1st Respondent culminating in its Advertisement No.R3/1/08(II-Revised) dated 02.09.2009 and quash the same and consequently directing the Respondents to follow the provisions of Tamil Nadu Arunthathiar (Special Reservation of seats in Educational Institutions including Private Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the services under the State within the reservation for the Scheduled Caste) Act, 2009 and to apply the rule of reservation and to consider merit of the Petitioner and consequently, to appoint the Petitioner as Assistant Professor in the 1st Respondent University.
