In view of the above, this criminal revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Connected Crl.M.P.No.2421 of 2018 is closed.

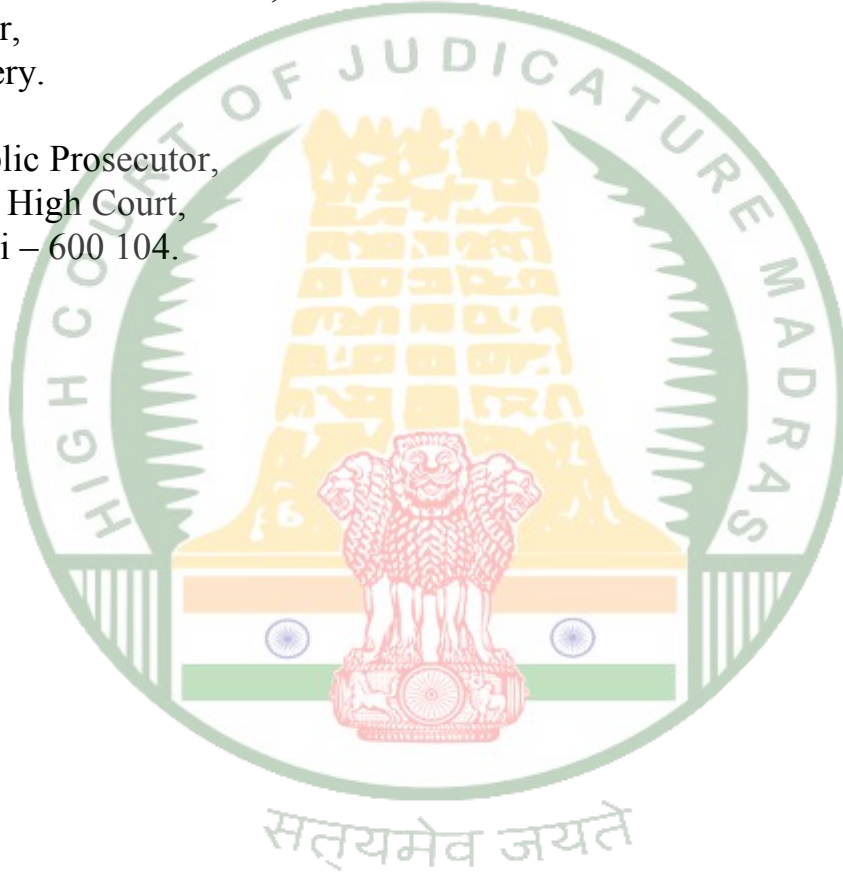
