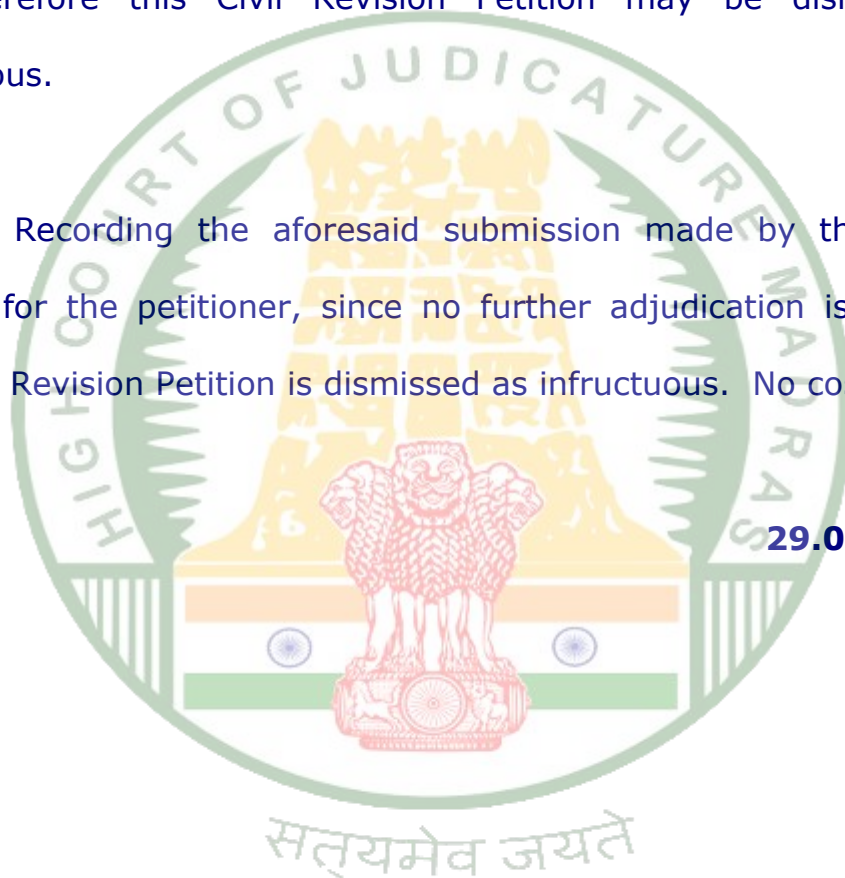
**ORDER**
