COMMON ORDER

Both sides counsel have submitted that the matter has been compromised between the parties and they have already filed a Joint Memo of Compromise on 20.07.2017 and requested to record the said Joint Memo of Compromise and dispose of C.R.P.No.2314 of 2015. 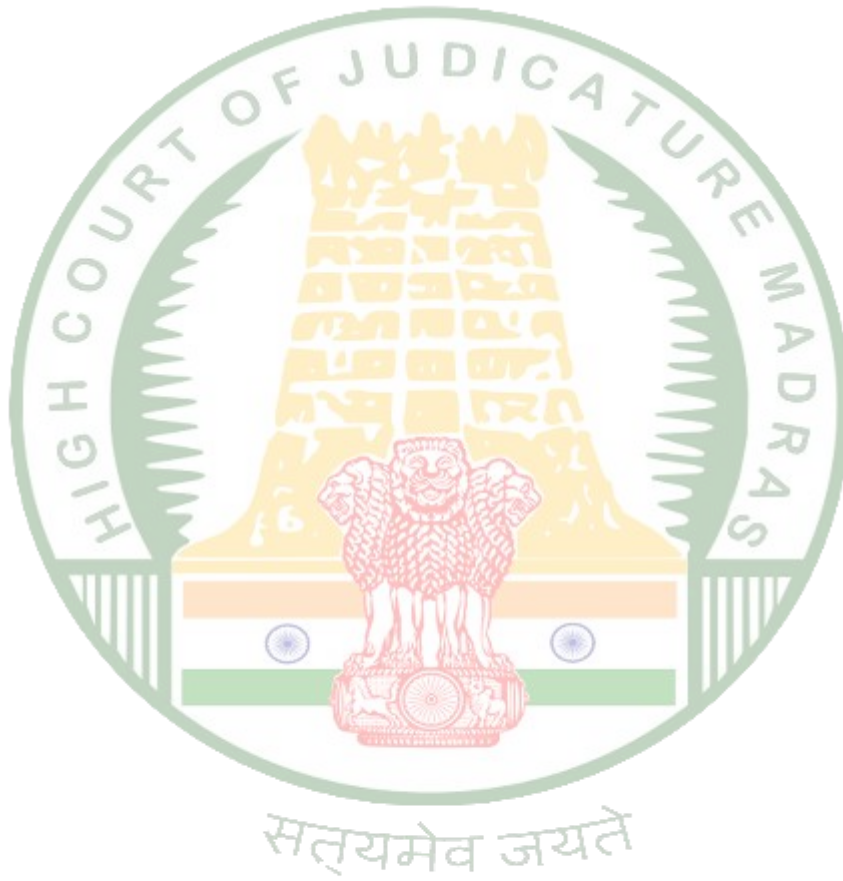
