COMMON ORDER

This Criminal Original Petitions have been filed to quash the F.I.R in Crime Nos.369 & 391 of 2019 on the file 1st respondent police.

2.The case is still in the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court which have been signed by the petitioners and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. All the parties are present and identified by their respective counsel and the Police. In order to identify the respective parties, they have also produced the copies of the Aadhaar Card and the same are made part of the record. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the First Information Report pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Guj Rath), this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the First Information Report in Crime Nos.369 & 391 of 2019.

5. This Criminal Original Petitions stand allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Crime Nos.369 & 391 of 2019, on the file of the 1st respondent police, is quashed and the terms of Joint Memo of Compromise shall form part and parcel

of this Order. The petitioners are jointly directed to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/-, as cost, (in each case) to the Tamil Nadu Legal Services Authority, within a period of one week from today and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a Memo, reporting compliance in the Registry. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
