PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus to call for the records relating to his uncle's detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order, dated 10.02.2020 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings C3/D.O.NO.05/2020 quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents herein to produce his uncle namely Thulasi son of Kuppusamy, aged 39 years before this Court and set his uncle at liberty from detention, now his uncle detained at Central Prison, Vellore.

2.The Petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in No. C3/D.O.NO.05/2020 dated 10.02.2020 detaining his uncle as "Bootlegger", as contemplated under Section 2(b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O. Rt. No.1423, Home, Prohibition and Excise (IX) Department, dated 16.03.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
