2.Recording the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, the Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

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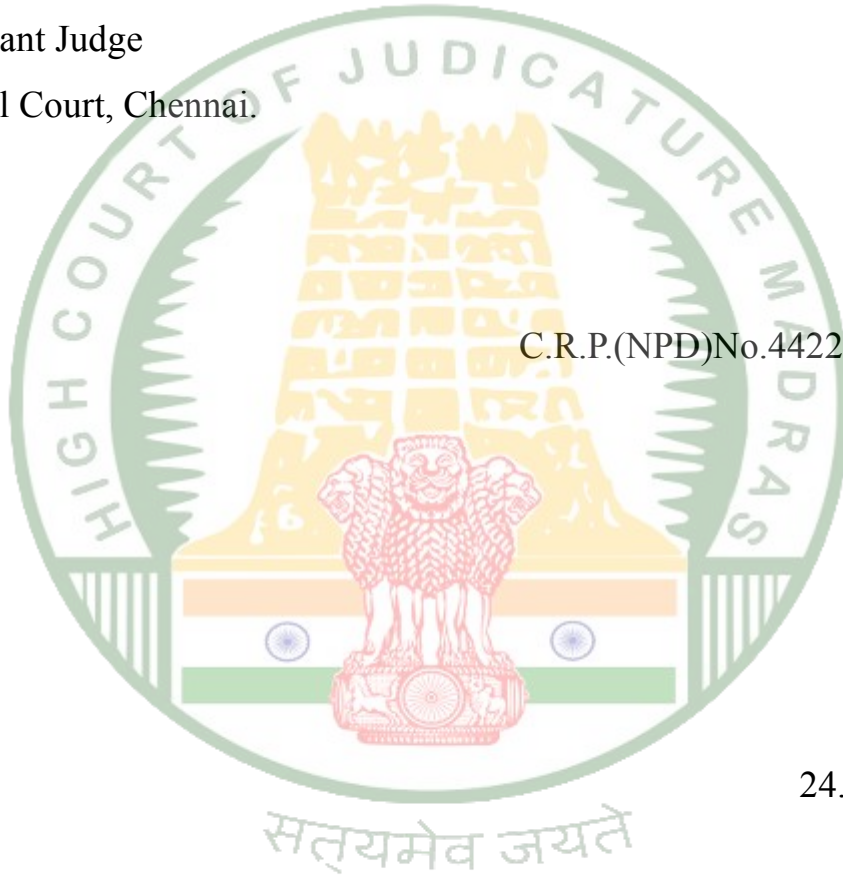
