This Court while suspending the sentence which was imposed by the trial court and confirmed by the appellate court, has directed the petitioner to appear before the trial court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m pending disposal of the revision. To relax the said condition, the present petition has been filed.

3. It is seen from the records that already the petitioner has filed a similar type of petition in Crl.MP.8991 of 2019 and the same was dismissed by this court on 10.07.2019, however, a liberty was given to the petitioner to file an application under Section 317 of Cr.P.C, if the petitioner is not able to appear on any particular day and appear before the Magistrate on any other day as determined by the Magistrate in lieu of the day on which the petitioner is absent. therefore, this Court does not find any merits in

this petition. Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
