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ORDER

When the matter was taken up today, learned counsel appearing for the 2nd respondent, on instructions submitted that though the petitioner has filed the petition to direct the 1st respondent to permit the petitioner to participate in the interview to the post of Assistant Professor-Stage IV(Associate Professor), Central Instrumentation Research and Service Department, University of Madras, Central Instrumentation
