PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus calling for the records in connection with the detention order passed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in Memo No.91/BCDFGISSSV/2020 dated 13.02.2020 against the petitioner's husband the detenu Mr.Seeni, S/o Nithiyanandam, aged about 24 years, before this Court who is now confined at Central Prison, Puzhal-II, Chennai and set him at liberty.

2.The Petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in Memo 91/BCDFGISSSV/2020 dated 13.02.2020 detaining her husband as "Drug Offender", as contemplated under Section 2(e) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O. Rt. No.1496, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIII) Department, dated 18.03.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
