PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus to call for the records in Memo No.112/BCDFGISSSV/2020 dated 20.02.2020 on the file of the 2nd respondent and quash the detention order as illegal and direct the respondents to produce the detenue Mr.Tamizh @ Lakshmanan, son of Chellakkannu, aged about 23 years, before this Court who is now confined at Central Prison, Puzhal-II, Chennai and set him at liberty.

2.The Petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in No. 112/BCDFGISSSV/2020 dated 20.02.2020 detaining his brother as "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O. Rt. No.1857, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIII) Department, dated 23.04.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

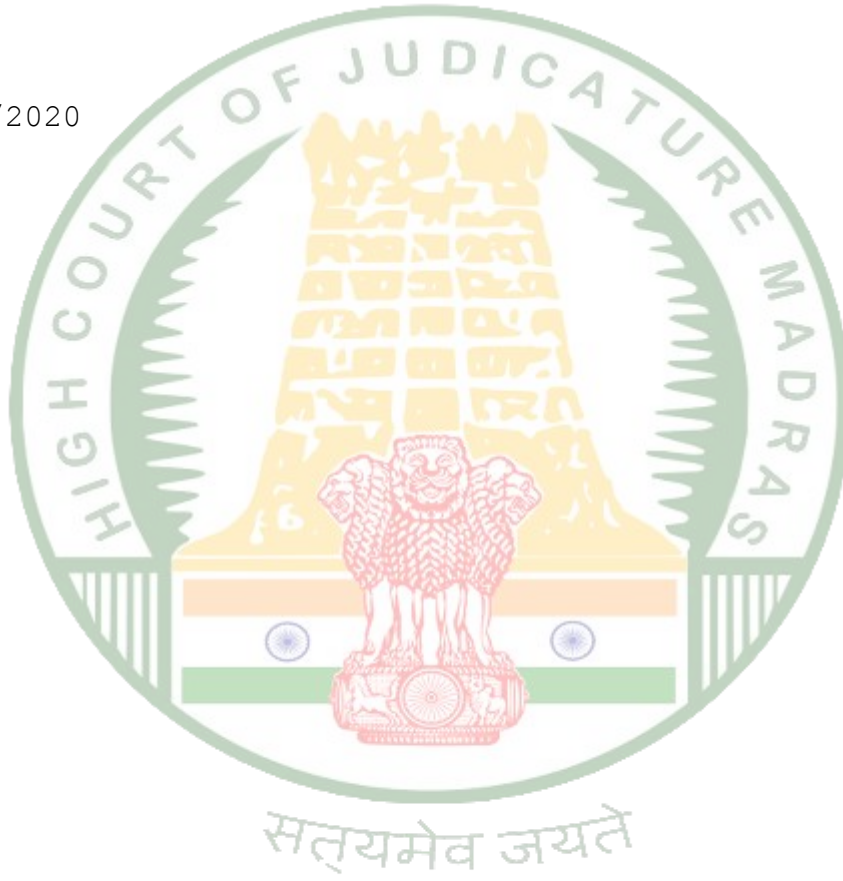
