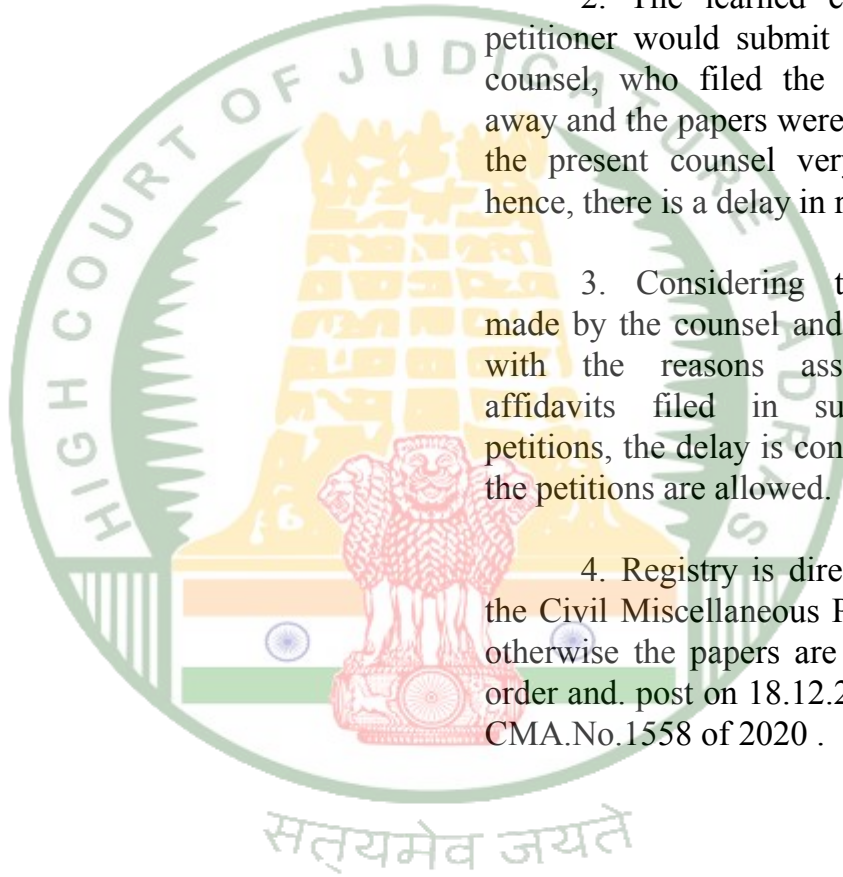

The petitioner/Appellant has filed the petitions to condone the delay of 654 days in filing the appeals.
