5.Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the delay of 101 days is condoned and the petition is ordered.

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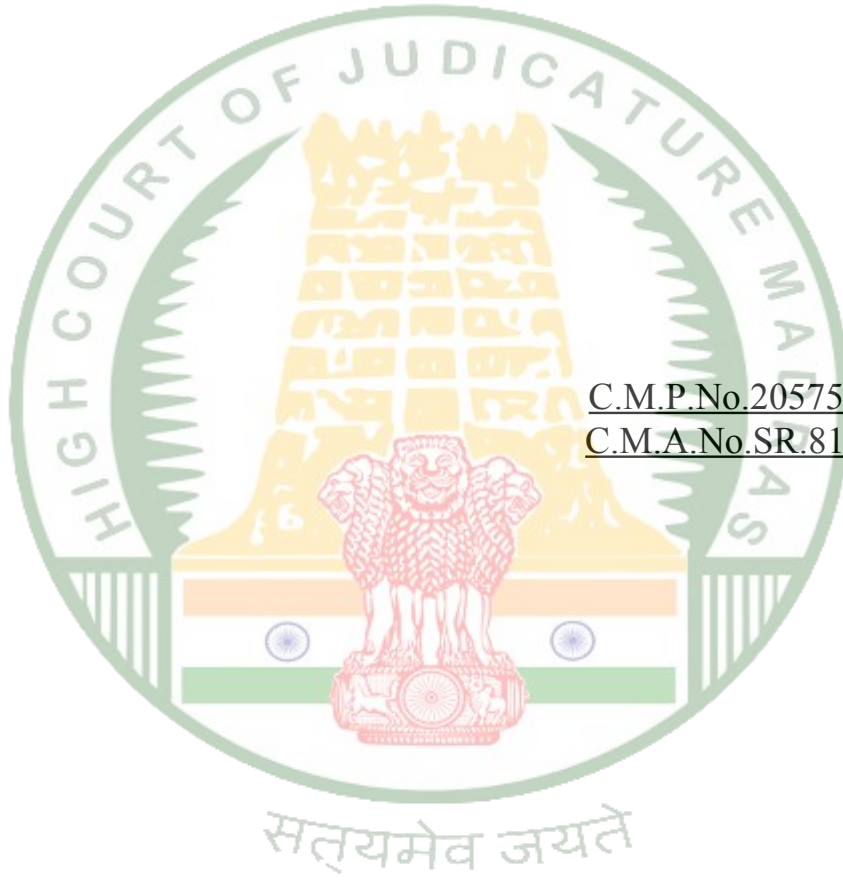
