PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, seeking Writ of Certiorari and Mandamus, calling for the records of the 1st respondent in its impugned communication dated 06.03.2020 in No.2774/Health/H5/2019-20/PF and the Memorandum No.1680/Health/H5/2019-20 dated 22.05.2020, quash the same insofar as the same states that unfilled minority quota seats in the petitioner Institution after two rounds of counselling would be filled up as open merit management quota seats based on All India Merit list and consequentially direct the respondents to conduct the mop-up round of counselling for admission of students into the PG medical courses offered by the Petitioner Institution for the Academic Year 2020 - 2021 by allotting the vacant seats to the Christian minority candidates belonging to other states on a preferential basis.
