ORDER

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No. 21 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that there was a wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant and the petitioner is said to have abused and intimated and caused simple injuries to the *de facto* complainant.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submitted that injured person has been discharged from the hospital and there are no previous cases against the petitioner.

4. Taking into consideration, the facts and circumstances of the case and also of the fact that the victim has already been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

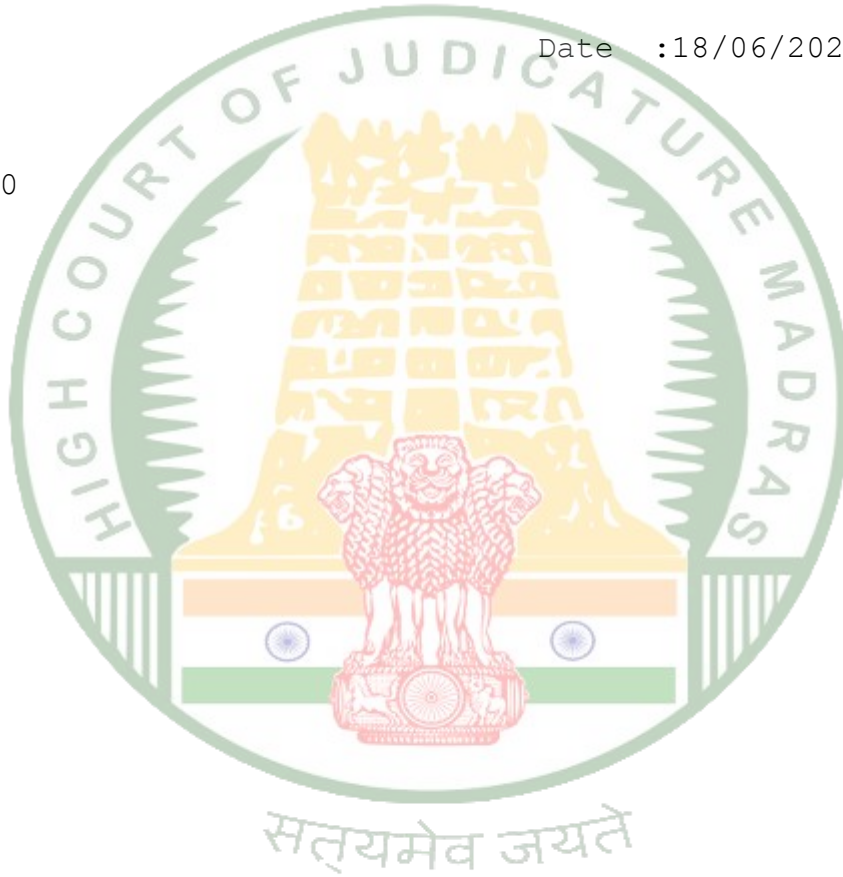
