Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to grant a general direction directing the 2nd respondent to file a report pertaining to the detention of the detinue by name Sheela D/o.Kathirvel in pursuance direct the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Vanur to dispose of the Crl.M.P.Not Known of 2020 in Crime No.978 of 2020 as expeditiously.

O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the mother of the detainee seeking for release of the detainee, who is now detained before the 3rd respondent Government Home for Woman.

2. The 1st respondent registered an FIR in Crime No.978 of 2020 for the offences under Sections 3(1), 4(1) and 5(1)(1), 6(1)(a) of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956. The petitioner is the mother of the 4th respondent viz., Sheela, who was produced before the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Vanur, showing her as a victim and she was detained in the home.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner filed a petition in Crime No.978/2020, seeking for the release of the petitioner's daughter and the same is kept pending on the ground that the P.O. report is yet to be filed before the Court. Aggrieved by the same, the present petition has been filed before this Court.

4. Taking into consideration the earlier orders passed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.27063 of 2018 and Crl.O.P.No.26714 of 2018, wherein this Court has dealt with an issue of similar nature and also the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to direct the third respondent to immediately release the fourth respondent from the Government Home for Women, Trichy. The petitioner, before taking her daughter, namely the fourth respondent from the home, shall produce necessary evidence to show her relationship with the fourth respondent. The fourth respondent, on being released from the home, shall report before the concerned Magistrate once in a week on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., till the P.O. report is submitted before the Court.

5. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.

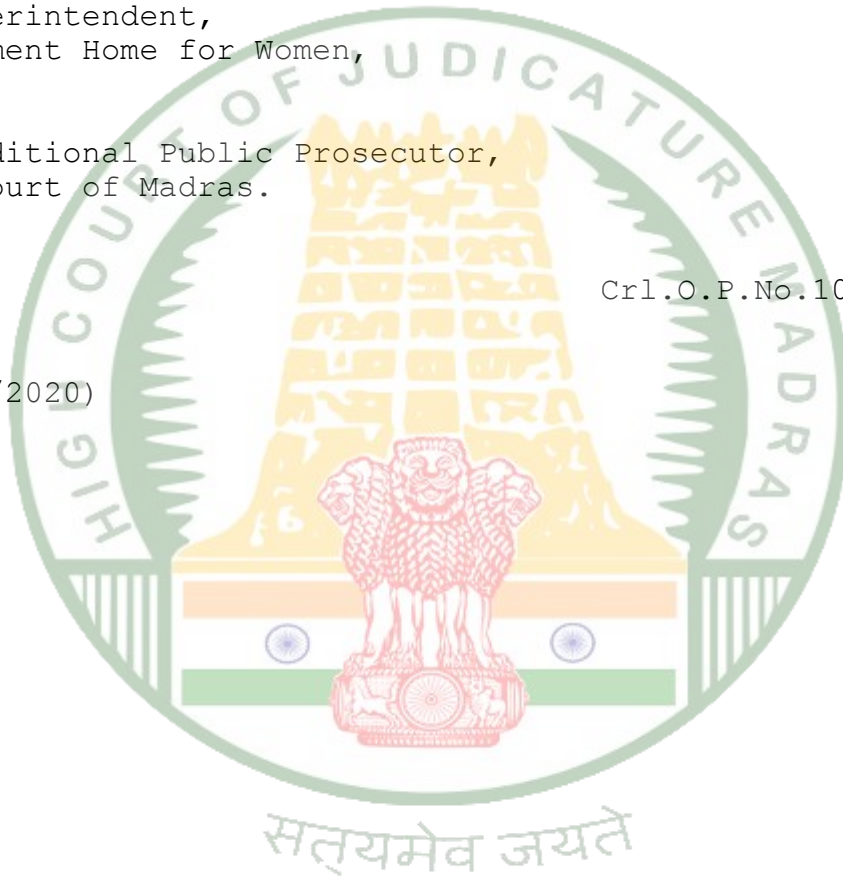
