Prayer : This Criminal Original Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Crime No.1128 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER

(This case has been heard through video conference)

The petitioner, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 02.06.2020 for the offences punishable under Sections 6(a), 24(1), 7(5) of Cigarette and other Tobacco Products Act 2003 and 273, 328 IPC in Crime No.1128 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with the other accused was found in possession of 225 Kgs of banned tobacco products. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. On instruction, he would further submit that without prejudice to their defence and contentions, the petitioner is prepared to deposit some considerable amount to any charitable organization or to any Association, and that the petitioners have been suffering incarceration from 02.06.2020. Hence, he prays to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner was found in possession of 225 kgs of banned tobacco products. He would

further submit that there is no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

(a) Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to deposit a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) to the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund, Indian Overseas Bank, Secretariat Branch, Chennai 600 009, S.B.A/c.No.117201000000070 IFS Code IOBA0001172 CMPRF AAAGC0038F** and on such deposit and production of proof and executing his own bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each, before the Superintendent of the concerned prison, in which the petitioner had been confined and thereafter, on his release;

(b) the petitioner shall execute two sureties for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Vellore, within 15 days from the date of lifting of the lockdown and commencement of the Court's normal functioning whichever is earlier, failing which the bail granted by this Court shall stand dismissed automatically.

(c) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surtey bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card of Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

(d) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30. a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

(e) the petitioner shall not commit any offences of similar in anture.

(f) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

(g) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(h) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala (2005) AIR SCW5560.

(i) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR

can be registered under Section 229 A IPC.

6. With the above directions, the Criminal Original Petition is ordered.
