COMMON ORDER

Application Nos.1680 and 1686 of 2020 have been filed to extend the tenure of the Hon'ble Justice Mr.A.P.Shah Chief Judge (Retd.), High Court, Madras, to resolve the dispute between the parties that arose under agreement, dated 24/12/2010, in Case Nos.1 and 2 respectively, by another six months from 8/8/2020.
