5. This Court, at this stage, is not expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, as it is for the second respondent to consider and decide the same.

Therefore, without expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of only with a direction to the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 15.06.2020 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing all the parties concerned. Such exercise shall be done by the second respondent within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
