PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 438 of Criminal Procedure Code to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in Crime No.0484 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

O R D E R

(The case has been heard through video conference)

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioner to enlarge him on interim/transit anticipatory bail in the event of arrest by the respondent in Crime No. 0484 of 2020 on the file of the second respondent police.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that a false complaint has been given against the petitioner and he has nothing to do with the said allegation. He further submitted that Interstate Anticipatory bail may be granted to him to enable him to move the appropriate jurisdictional Court for necessary relief.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions would submit that the first respondent has no intention to arrest the petitioner, however, on instructions he would submit that there is a case pending against the petitioner before the second respondent police station.

4. Taking into consideration that there is no apprehension of arrest by the first respondent, this Court is inclined to grant inter-state anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. The inter-state anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner on condition that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned XVII Metropolitan Magistrate, Saidapet, Chennai within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready and the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the said learned Magistrate. Further, within two weeks from the date of execution of bail bond, the petitioner shall approach the competent jurisdictional Court within the State of Uttar Pradesh and seek appropriate relief failing which, the anticipatory bail shall automatically get cancelled.
