However, the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police, after lifting of the lockdown or the commencement of the Court's normal functioning whichever is earlier, on the first working day of every month until further orders.

5 With the above directions, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is ordered.

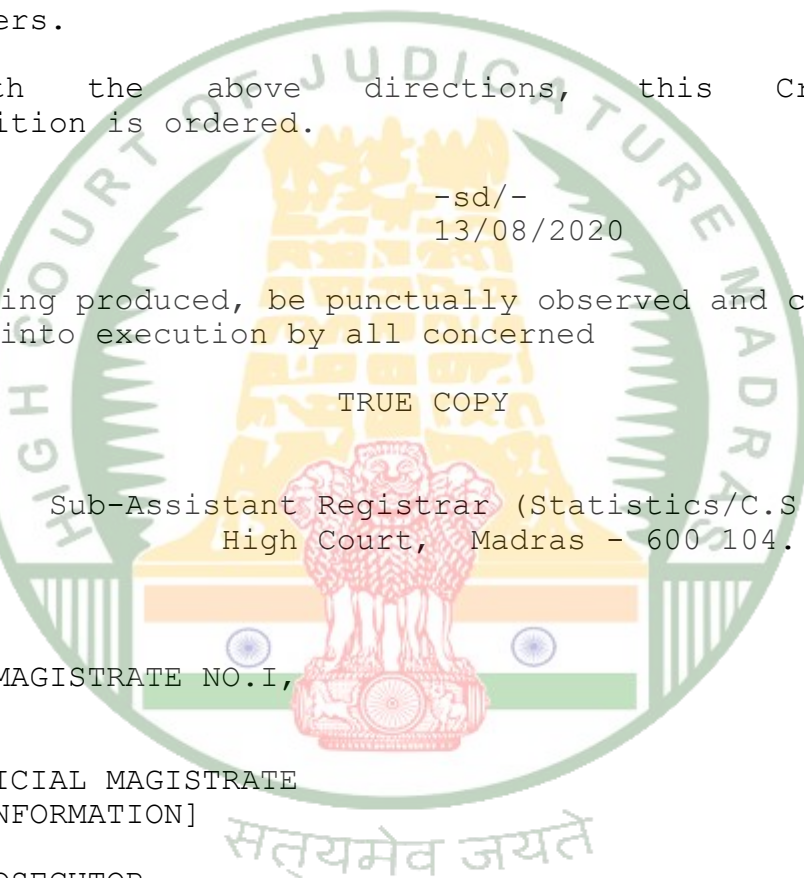
