O R D E R

In this miscellaneous petition, on 02.07.2019, an order of interim stay was granted subject to condition that the petitioner should deposit 20% of the compensation awarded i.e.,Rs.3,15,400/- on or before 30.07.2019. While passing such order, it was specifically mentioned therein that in the event of failure on the part of the petitioner to deposit the said amount within the specified period, the interim stay granted would stand automatically vacated without any further reference to this Court.

2.Today, when the case was taken up for consideration, the learned counsel appearing for the appellant submitted that the petitioner has not complied with the aforesaid conditional order.

3.In view of the above, this petition stands dismissed, by virtue of the specific clause in the order dated 02.07.2019 as stated in the paragraph No.1 of this order.
