two weeks time from the date of receipt of a copy of this order is granted to enable the petitioner to file appropriate application. Status quo as on today shall be maintained till then. We make it clear that all the issues are left open. No costs. Consequently, connected WMP is closed.

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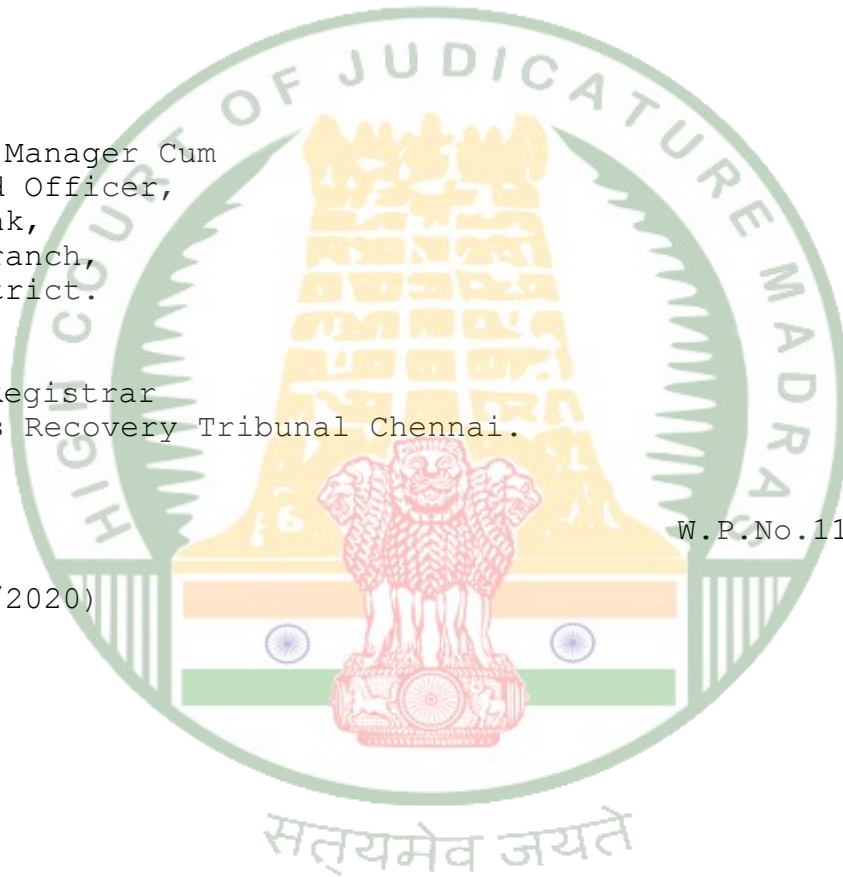
