On such settlement of the dues, the respondent/Corporation is prepared to settle the entire terminal benefits.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the amount due from the petitioner can be adjusted from the terminal benefits and the balance amount can be paid to the petitioner.

3. In view of the above development, there shall be a direction to the respondent to deduct the amount due and payable by the petitioner and pay

the balance terminal benefits to the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

4. This Contempt Petition is disposed of, accordingly.
