O R D E R

The Revenue Divisional Officer, Chengleput is suo-motu impleaded as the 12<sup>th</sup> respondent in this Writ Petition.

2.This Writ Petition has been filed for the issue of Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation made by the petitioner on 12.08.2020, wherein the petitioner has sought for cancellation of patta issued in favour of respondents 5 to 10.

3. Learned Special Govt. Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 to 4 and 12 submitted that based on the representation made by the petitioner, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has fixed the preliminary enquiry to be conducted on 30.09.2020 at 11 a.m.

4.The learned counsel submitted that the petitioner can be present at the time of enquiry with all the relevant documents and after hearing all the parties, a report will be submitted before the 12<sup>th</sup> respondent and the 12<sup>th</sup> respondent, will, thereafter, pass orders in accordance with law.

5.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also of the fact that the representation given by the petitioner is already being enquired by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, there shall be a direction to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to conduct the enquiry after affording sufficient opportunity to the petitioner and respondents 5 to 11 and submit a report before the 12<sup>th</sup> respondent within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The 12<sup>th</sup> respondent shall thereafter, pass appropriate orders strictly in accordance with law within a period of four weeks .

6. This Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
