ORDER

(The case has been heard through video conference)

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioners to enlarge them on interim / transit anticipatory bail

in the event of arrest by the respondent in Crime No. Not Known on the file of the respondent police.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that a false complaint has been given against the petitioners and they have nothing to do with the said allegations. He further submitted that Interstate Anticipatory bail may be granted to them to enable them to move the appropriate jurisdictional Court for necessary relief.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions would submit that the 2nd respondent has no intention to arrest the petitioner, however, on instructions he would submit that there are no previous cases is pending against the petitioners before the second respondent police station.

4.Taking into consideration that there is no apprehension of arrest by the 2nd respondent, this Court is inclined to grant interstate interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5.The interim interstate anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioners for a period of **four weeks ie., til 16.10.2020**, on condition that the petitioners shall surrender before the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready and the petitioners shall execute a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the said learned Magistrate. Further, within two weeks from the date of execution of bail bond, the petitioners shall approach the competent jurisdictional Court within the State of Karnataka and seek appropriate relief failing which, this anticipatory bail shall automatically get cancelled.
