4. This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

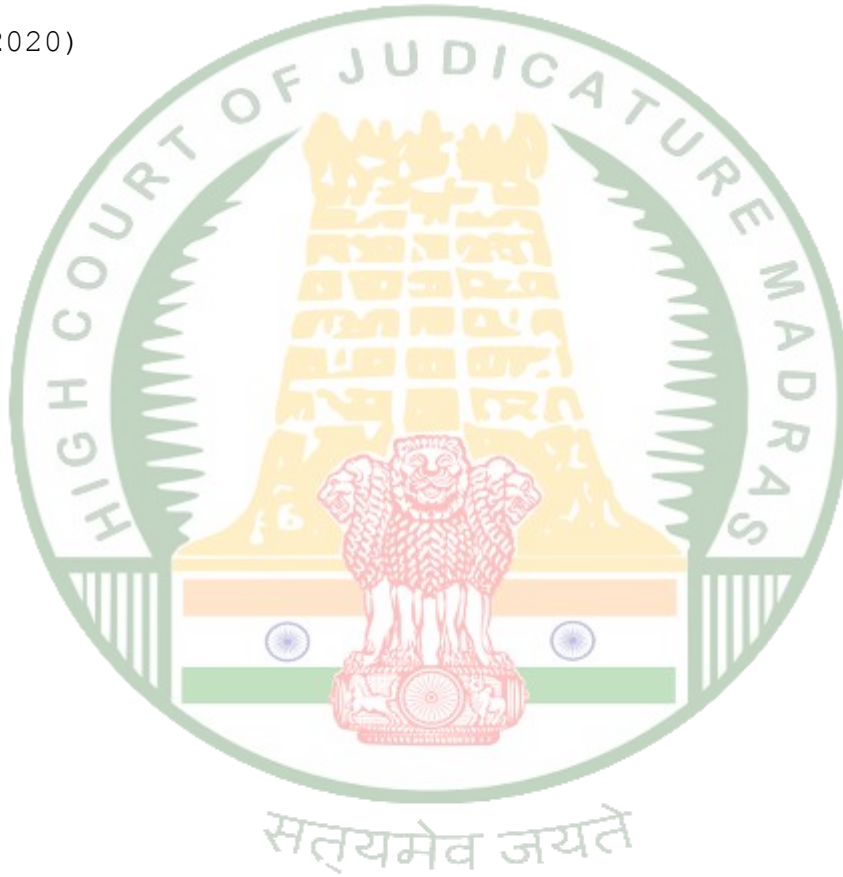
