2.The issue pertains to the Central Government Services and therefore, only Central Administrative Tribunal alone has jurisdiction and not this Court. Therefore, this writ petition

is dismissed as not maintainable. No costs. Consequently,
connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

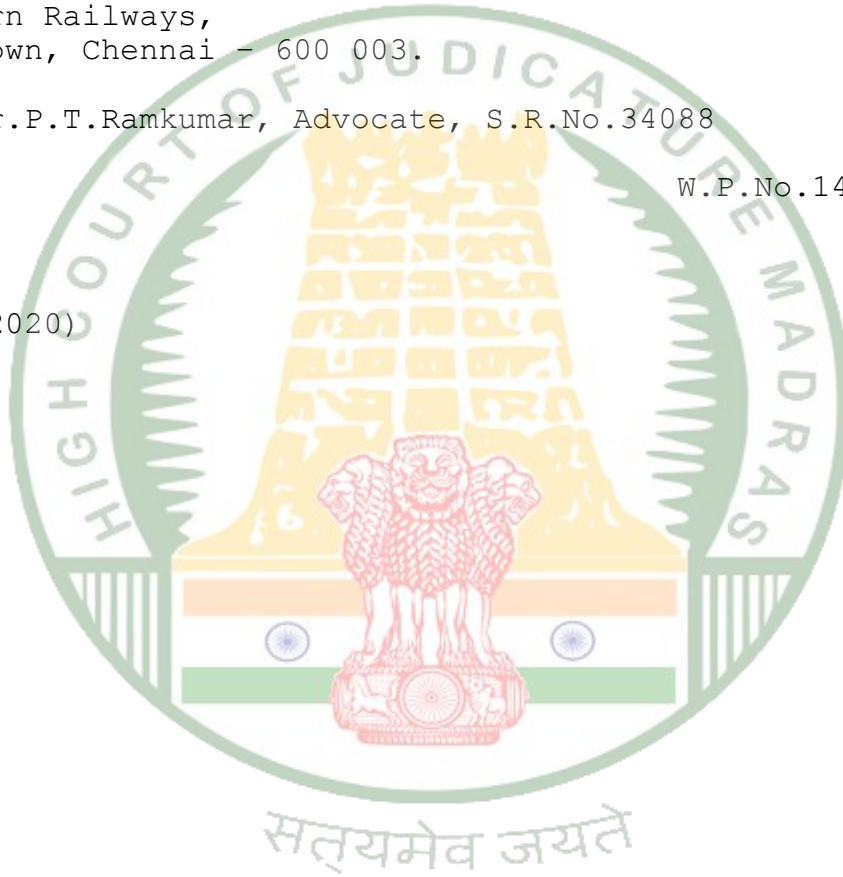
