3.Mr.K.Parameshwaran, learned Government Advocate, appearing on behalf of the 5th and 6th respondents, submitted that the 5th respondent, namely the Revenue Divisional Officer, has already fixed the date of enquiry on 23.10.2020 at 11.00 a.m. The learned counsel also submitted that the petitioner can be present for the enquiry along with all the relevant documents.

4.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also of the fact that the 5th respondent has already called the petitioner for an enquiry, there shall be a direction to the 5th respondent to conduct the enquiry and pass orders, strictly in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No costs.
