Of common area totally 1994 sq.ft. out of 3550 sq.ft. more fully described in the petition and to operate his bank accounts.

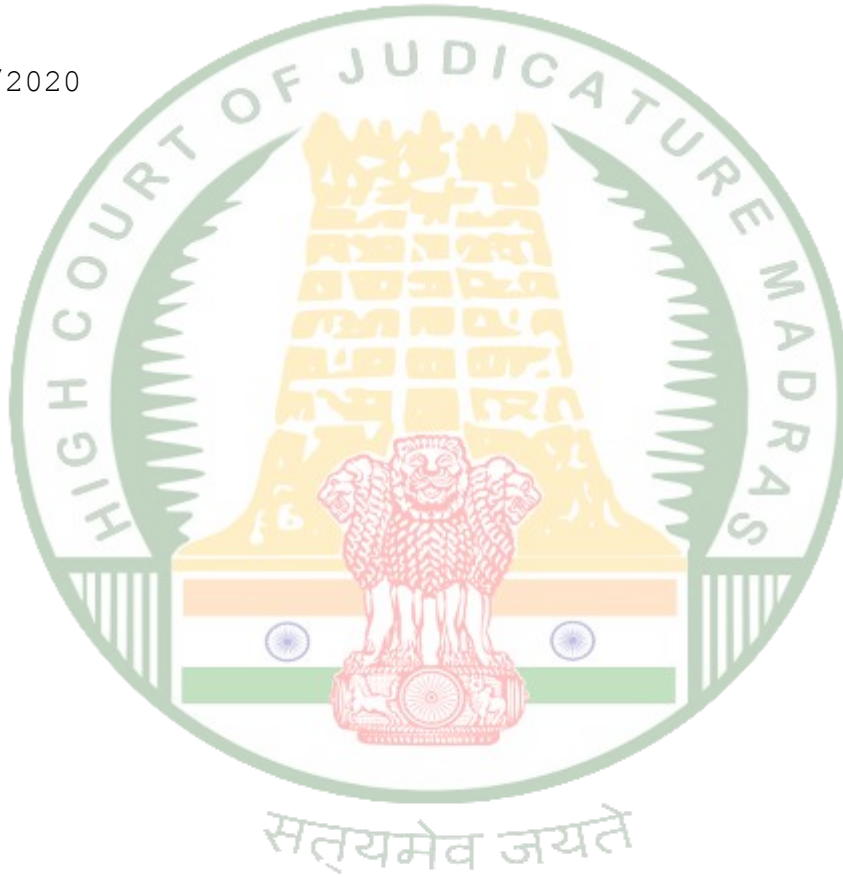
