2.The date of birth of the detenue is 23.03.2002. Therefore, as admitted by the petitioner himself, she is major. The detenue has married the second respondent on 25.06.2020 and she is not willing to go with the petitioner.

3. As the detenue is the major and since she married the

second respondent, we do not find any illegal detention is involved. The detenue is set at liberty and the Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.

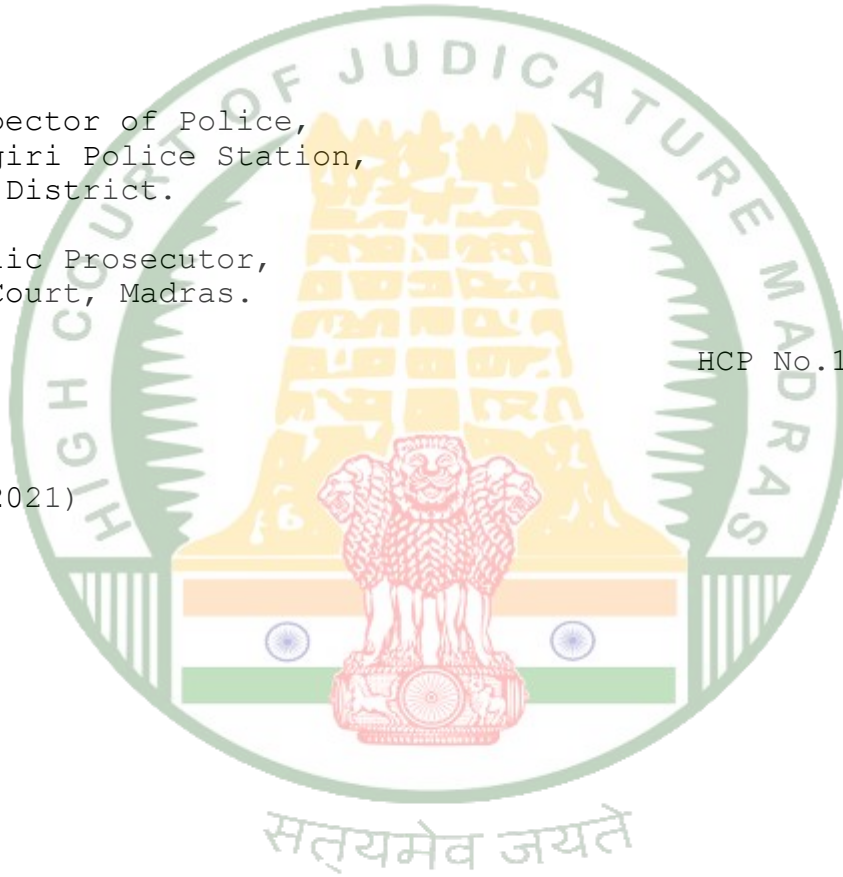
