PRAYER: Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code praying to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.13114 of 2020 by order dated 03.09.2020 as the petitioner shall deposit a title deed document Nos.1682 of 2013 and 2809 of 2013 instead of Document No.2800 of 2013 stands in the name of the petitioner or his wife to the credit of Crime No.786 of 2020, before the concerned Magistrate.

ORDER

This petition has been filed to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.13114 of 2020 by order dated 03.09.2020 as the petitioner shall deposit a title deed document Nos.1682 of 2013 and 2809 of 2013 instead of Document No.2800 of 2013 stands in the name of the petitioner or his wife to the credit of Crime No.786 of 2020, before the concerned Magistrate.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that this Court had granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Crl.O.P.No.13114 of 2020 dated 03.09.2020 with some conditions and one of the condition is that the petitioner shall deposit a title deeds of document Nos.1682 of 2013 and 2809 of 2013 which stands in the name of the petitioner or his wife to the credit of Crime No.786 of 2020, before the concerned Magistrate. He further submitted that the petitioner had wrongly mentioned the document number as “2809 of 2013” instead of document No.2800 of 2013. Therefore, he seeks for modification of the conditions imposed by this court in Crl.O.P.No.13114 of 2020 dated 03.09.2020.

3. Considering the said submission, the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.13114 of 2020 dated 03.09.2020 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall deposit title deeds bearing document **“Nos.1682 of 2013 and 2800 of 2013”** instead of Document **“Nos.1682 of 2013 and 2809 of 2013”** stands in the name of the petitioner or his wife to the credit of Crime No.786 of 2020, before the concerned Magistrate. The time for depositing the documents is extended by two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above directions, this criminal miscellaneous petition is ordered.

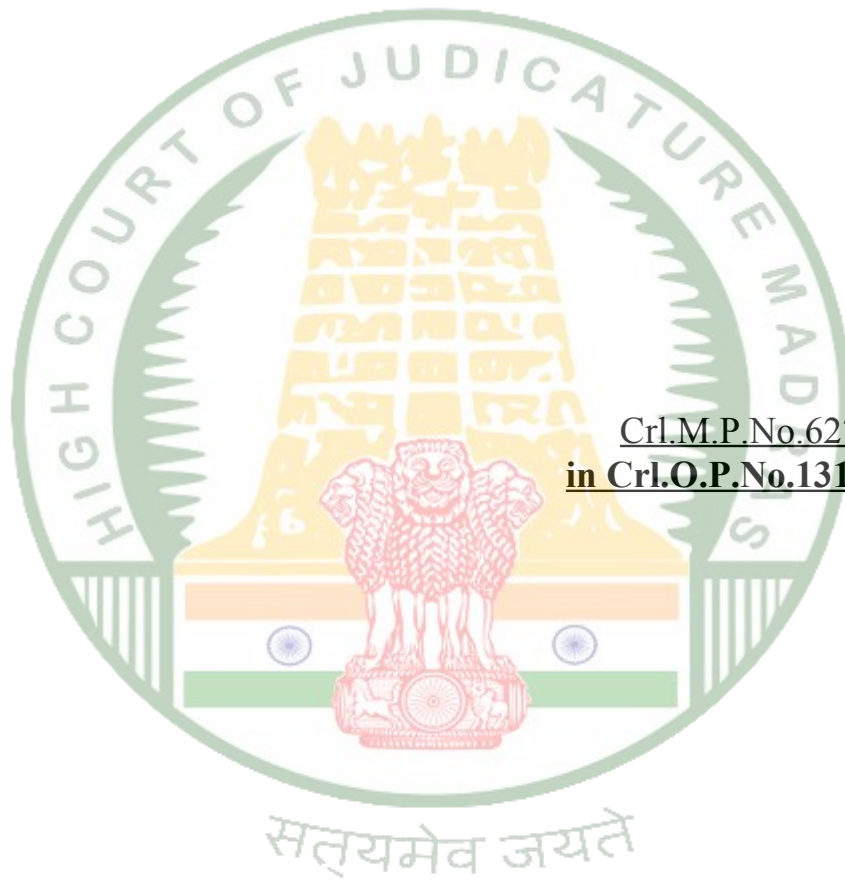
