COMMON ORDER

These criminal original petitions have been filed seeking to call for the records in C.C.Nos. 4, 5, 6 & 7 of 2014 pending on the file of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Villupuram and quash the same.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that without going into the merits of the case, it would suffice, if this Court issues direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial and complete the same as early as possible. He would further submit that the appearance of the petitioner before the Trial Court may be dispensed with and would further submit that the petitioner is ready to appear as and when necessary.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent concede to the request made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, this Court directs the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Villupuram, to expedite the trial in C.C.No. 4, 5, 6 & 7 of 2014 and complete the same as early as possible. The appearance of the petitioners before the

Trial Court is dispensed with. However, this order will not stand on the way of the Trial Court to insist for the appearance of the petitioners for receiving copies under Section 207 of Cr.P.C., framing of charges, questioning under Section 313 of Cr.P.C. and judgment and as and when the Trial Court feels it necessary.

5. With the above directions, these criminal original petitions are disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
