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These matters have been posted under the caption 'for extension of time' before this Court.

2. This Court by judgment dated 07.02.2020 directed the I Additional Family Court, Chennai to dispose of O.P. No. 2171 of 2016 within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of that judgment.

3. However, the Judge, I Additional Family Court, Chennai vide communication dated 09.06.2021 requests time for disposing of the aforesaid case, since the court cannot function effectively due to Covid-19 pandemic situation and more over, parties are also not present before that Court.

4. In view of that, six months time is granted as sought for.

5. Since there is a reference in the letter dated 09.06.2021 that Parties have preferred SLP No.15303-15306 of 2020 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Trial Court is directed to get a memo from both parties as to whether there is a stay of the proceedings or not and the Trial Court is advised not to proceed with the matter, If there is a stay of the proceedings, otherwise, the Trial Court is directed to proceed with the matter.
