ORDER

This writ petition is heard through Videoconferencing, on account of the COVID-19 pandemic situation.

2. The petitioner has sought for a mandamus forbearing the respondent from seizing the petitioner's tanker lorries 8 in numbers.

3. For the purpose of business, the petitioner had purchased 9 tanker lorries, which were hypothecated with the respondent-bank. In view of the default in payments, the respondent attempted to re-possess the vehicles. Hence, the above writ petition is filed.

4. Only notice was issued at the time of admission. Mr.S.Suresh, learned counsel, representing the respondent-bank, states that subsequent to the filing of this writ petition, the petitioner had settled the amounts due to the respondent-bank.

5. As the amounts were settled, no further order needs to be passed in this writ petition and hence the same is closed. No Costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

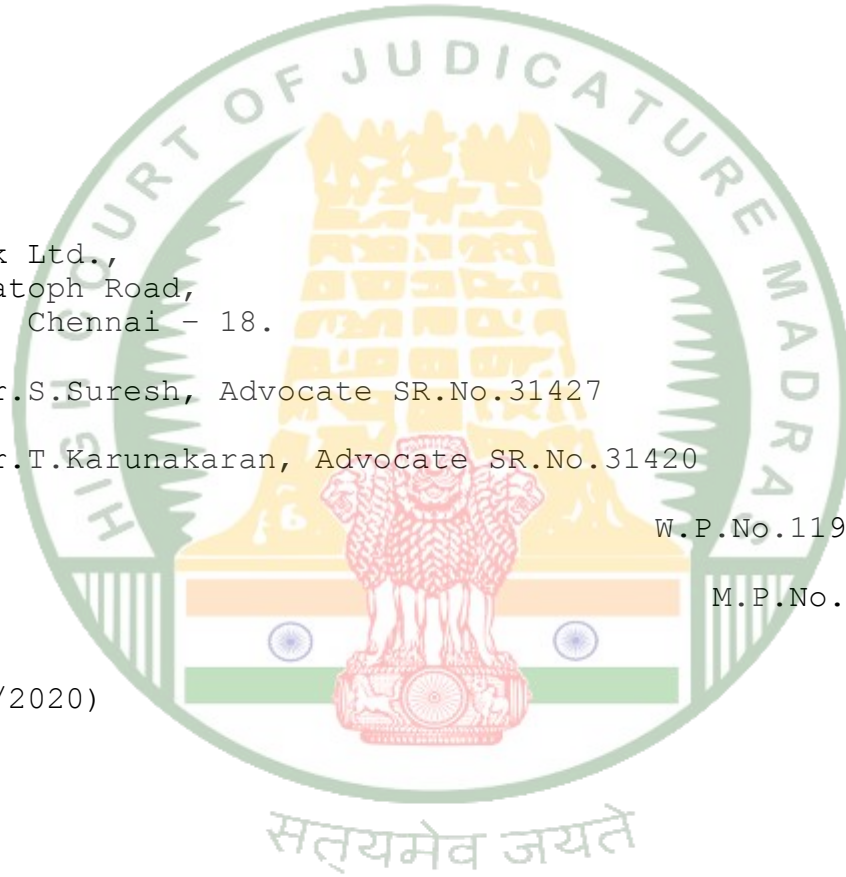
