5. Accordingly, these Writ Petitions are dismissed. The petitioners are granted time till 15.11.2020 to vacate and handover the possession to the official respondents/TNHB. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

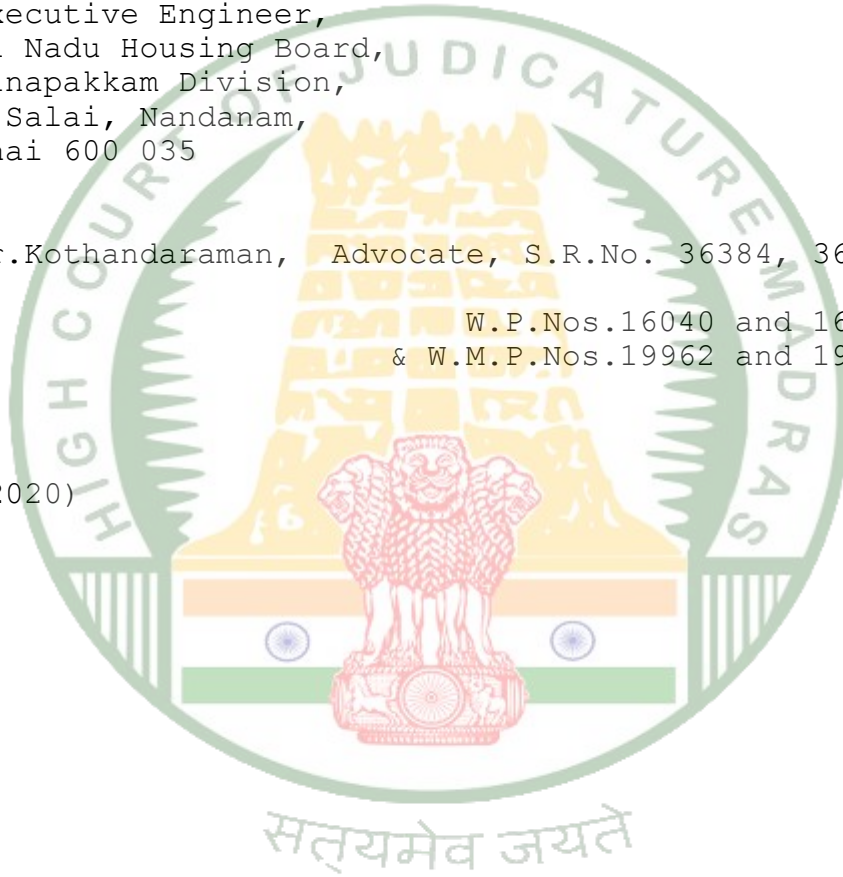
