This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pass fresh award by redetermining the amount of compensation in accordance with Sec 28A of the Land Acquisition Act 1894 in the light of Judgment and Decree dated 28.2.2020 made in L.A.O.P. No. 138 of 2000 on the file of the Land Acquisition Tribunal Namakkal with respect to the petitioners acquired land comprised in Survey No. 380/2 measuring an extent of 1.42.5 Hectare situated at Siluvampatti Village, Namakkal Taluk and District based on the representation of the petitioners dated 01.07.2020.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed for the issue of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation made by the petitioners on 01.07.2020, wherein

the petitioners are seeking for the redetermination of the compensation in accordance with Section 28(A) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (herein after called as 'Act').

2. Heard Mr.S.Senthil, learned counsel for petitioners and Mr.D.Raja, learned Additional Government Pleader for respondents.

3. It is seen from records that 4(1) notification was issued on 05.06.1998 and thereafter, the award came to be passed by the second respondent by proceedings dated 17.03.1999. Admittedly, the petitioners have not sought for any reference under Section 18(1) of the Act.

4. Some of the other land owners under the same notification had sought for a reference under Section 18 of the Act and the matter was referred to the competent Civil Court in LAOP No.138 of 2000 on the file of the Sub-Court, Namakkal. The Court has ultimately enhanced the compensation at the rate of Rs.26/- per sq.ft by virtue of a Judgment and Decree dated 28.02.2020.

5. The petitioners, immediately, on coming to know of the enhancement of compensation granted by the competent Civil Court have made a representation to the respondents on 01.07.2020 seeking for redetermination of the compensation on the basis of the award passed by the Court. Since the same was not considered, the present Writ Petition has been filed before this Court.

6. The only issue that is involved in the present Writ Petition is whether the petitioners, who have not sought for a reference under Section 18(1) of the Act, will be entitled for redetermination of the amount of compensation on the basis of the Judgment in LAOP No.138 of 2000 dated 28.02.2020. The law on this issue is well settled and it has been categorically held that even where the claimant has not made any reference under Section 18 of the Act, he will always be entitled to claim compensation at par with others where the compensation has been enhanced. Useful reference can be made to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "V.Ramakrishna Rao .. vs.. Singareni Collieries Company Ltd.," reported in 2011 (1) MLJ 351.

7. In view of the above, this Court is inclined to issue appropriate directions to the respondents to deal with the representation made by the petitioners in accordance with law.

8. This Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the first respondent to consider the representation made by the petitioners on 01.07.2020 and deal with the same in

accordance with Section 28(A) of the Act and pass final orders within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioners are directed to make a fresh representation to the first respondent along with all the relevant documents and also a copy of this order. No costs.

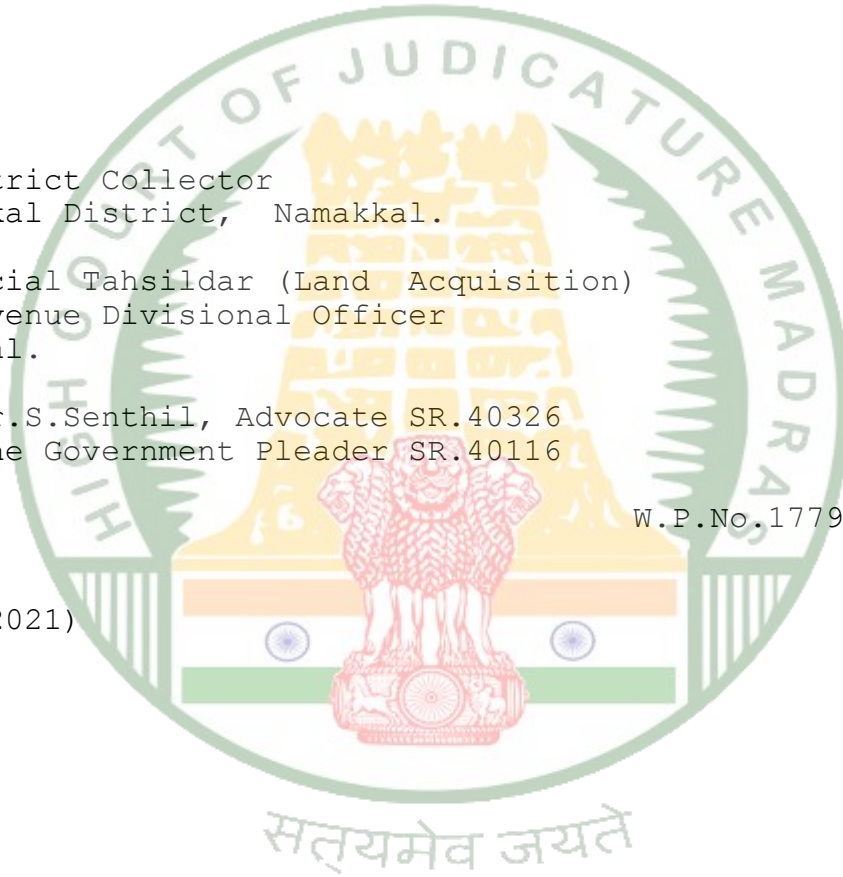
