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ORDER

By an order dated 23.09.2019, this Court had directed the respondent herein to consider the petitioner's representation dated

Today, when the matter was called, the learned Additional Government Pleader produced the copy of the proceedings dated 10.12.2020, by which, the petitioner's representation dated 27.06.2019 has been considered and orders were passed stating that the allegations levelled by the petitioner were enquired into and found to be false.

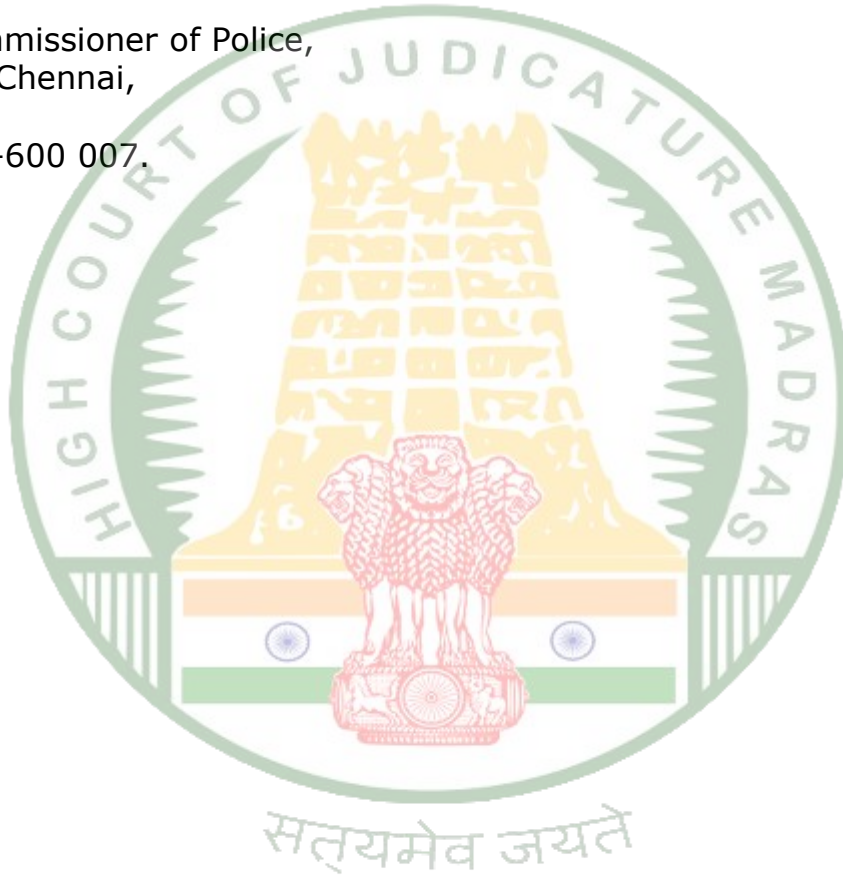

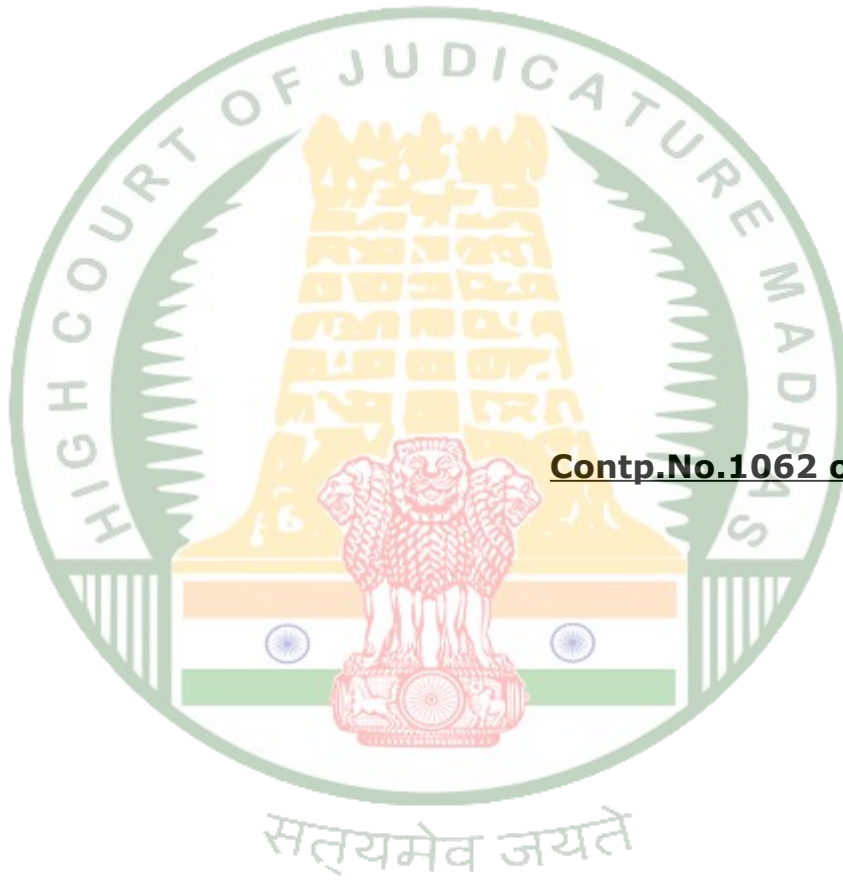
