2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the plaintiff is willing to file a petition, due to some error, it was filed by the witness.

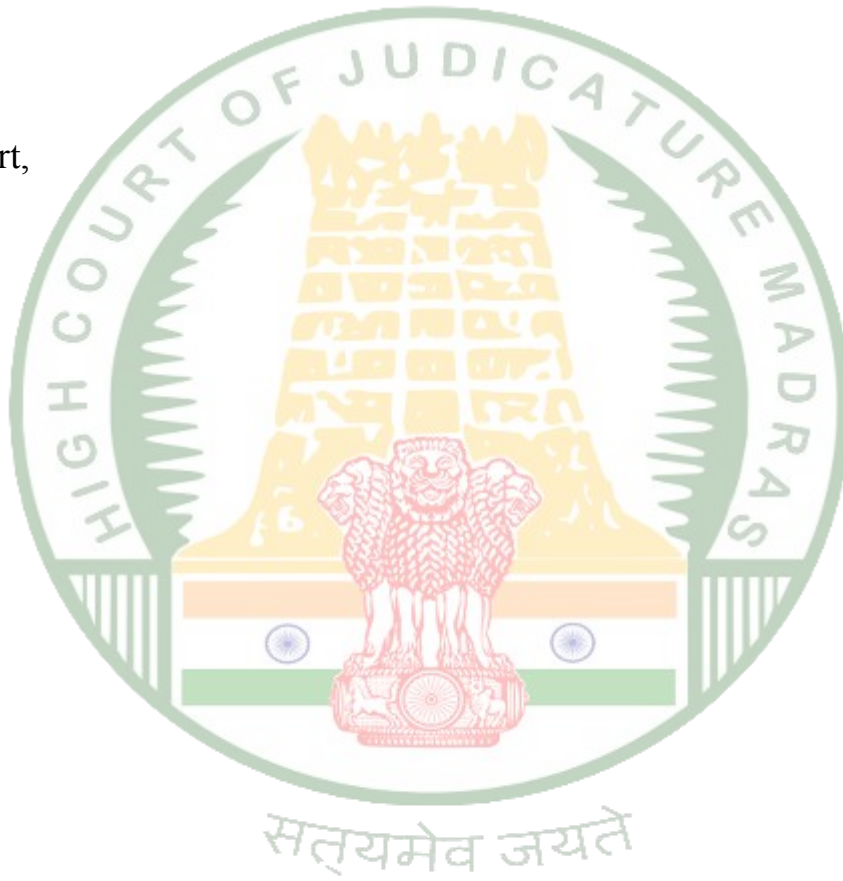

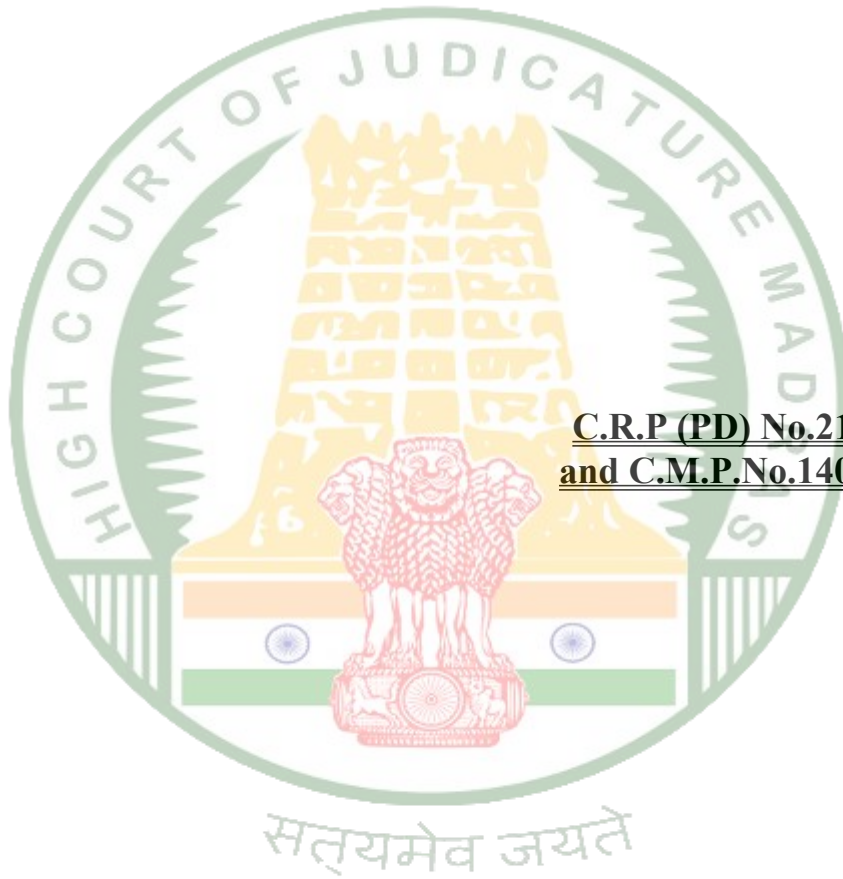
