By order dated 08.07.2019, this Court had appointed one Mr.Vijendra Kumar Sahu, Territory Manager – Collections, of the Applicant company as a receiver to seize and possess the vehicle, which is more fully described in the schedule to the Judges Summons.

2. Today, when the matter was called, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that the vehicle could not be secured and sought for extension of time for execution of order by the receiver and submitted that further time of four weeks may be granted to repossess the vehicle and submitted that the application may be closed. Accordingly, time is extended finally for a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which the Order granting power to repossess the vehicle shall automatically stand cancelled.

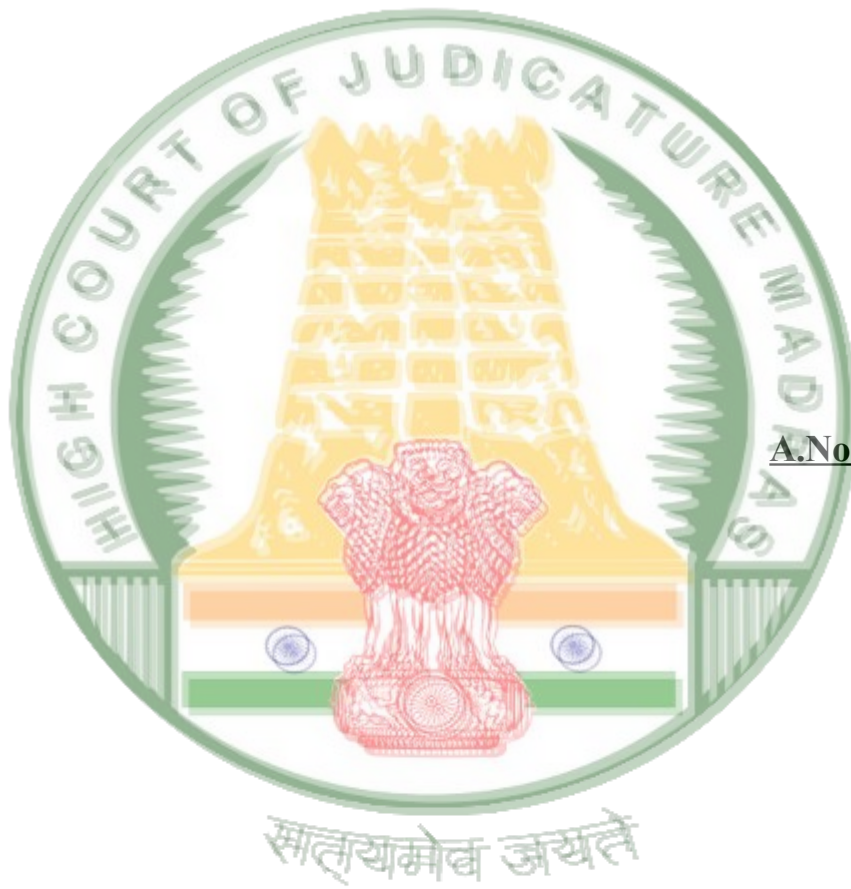
3. With the above direction, the application is closed.
