ORDER

(The case has been heard through video conference)

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences publishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B) of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, in Crime No.1743 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused were found in possession of 1.100 Kgs of Ganja, without any valid license or permit. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and a false case has been foisted against him. He would further submit that on the confession statement given by the co-accused, the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that petitioner along with other accused was found in possession of 1.100 Kgs of Ganja and the same was recovered from the petitioner. He would further submit that the petitioner has previous cases and hence he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the allegations and also the bad antecedents and that investigation is still pending and that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is essential, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
