Petitioner has come forward to file the instant Habeas Corpus Petition inter alia alleging that the detenue Seetha, aged about 23 years, is under the illegal custody of the respondents 3 and 4.

2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, detenue is present. During enquiry, she submitted that she is living with her parents and she also filed a petition for divorce.

3. Despite our efforts to make the detenue and her husband to interact, she refused. As we find no illegal detention involved, instant Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
