2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions regularly and hence, he seeks for relaxation of the condition.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner had complied with the condition only for three days i.e., from 3rd March 2020 to 5th March 2020 and thereafter, he has not been complied with the condition as directed by this Court.

4.In view of the above submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Court is not inclined to grant the relaxation to the petitioner.

5.With this observation, this criminal miscellaneous petition is dismissed.
