O R D E R

The relief sought for in the writ petition is a Mandamus directing the first respondent viz., Revenue Divisional Officer, Perambalur District, to pass order on the appeal filed by the petitioner dated 30.07.2018.

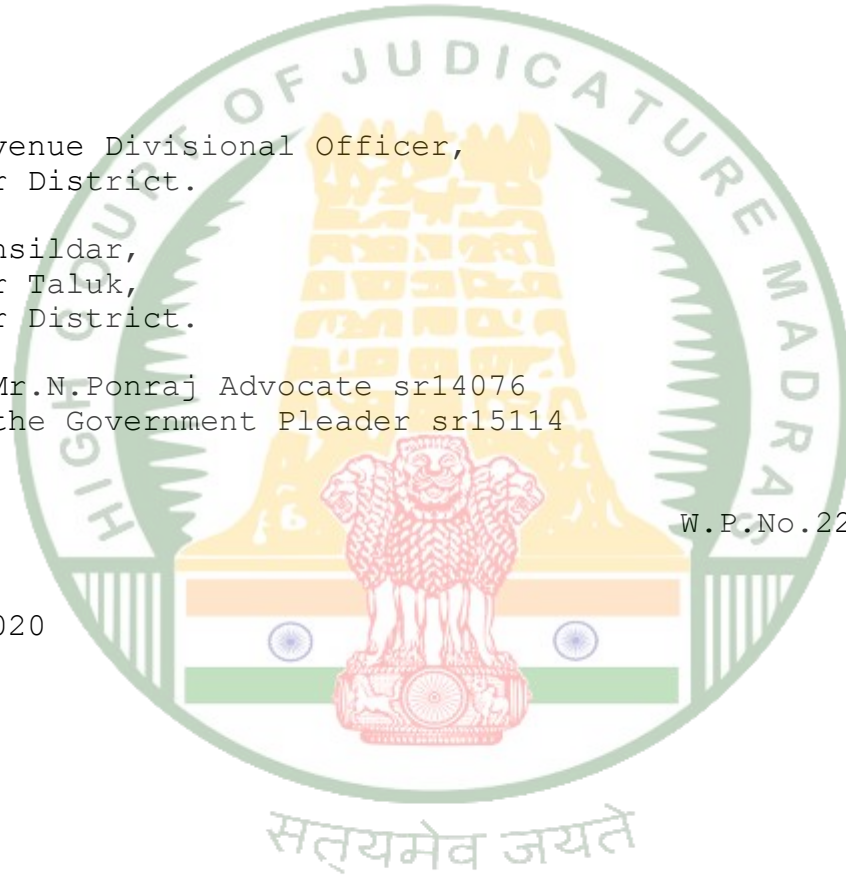
